



Environmental and social responsibility issues are important to us at Photowall. We strive to minimise the environmental impact of our production processes.

All production is to order, which means we only produce the quantity of products required, none are held in stock or discarded un-necessarily. The printing ink we use for our wallpapers contains no solvents or hazardous chemicals, and is biodegradable.

Waste material from our processes is recycled by environmental entrepreneur Hans Andersson Recycling AB.



Wallpaper material (standard)

The material is free of PVC and is CE labelled in accordance with EN 15102 and standard RAL GZ 479 on the control of heavy metals and formaldehyde, and the values are well below the norm.



Wallpaper material (premium)

The material is free of PVC and is CE labelled in accordance with EN 15102 and standard RAL GZ 479 on the control of heavy metals and formaldehyde, and the values are well below the norm. A further layer which is biodegradable has been applied to the material.



Wallpaper glue

Our wallpaper glue is made from natural raw materials and is biodegradable.



Canvas

Our canvases are made from a cotton-polyester blend. Our stretchers are made from wood and metal, both of which are recyclable.



Wrapping

The raw material in our boxes comprises wholly or partially recycled material and the only additive is starch.
Our products are only transported on full trailers.
